In the light of the above, the course on Pedagogy for Higher Education titled **Pedagogical Imperatives for Capacity Building in Higher Education** has been conceptualized under the aegis of Institute of Lifelong Learning. It has been prepared by Professor Vandana Saxena and Team from Department of Education who have expertise in various specialized areas in the field of education. The course has been rigorously vetted by experts and insightful faculty members from diverse disciplinary areas from across various institutions of University of Delhi to further strengthen it from multiple perspectives. Hence, the course not only has high rigour in terms of its quality but has been evolved in the light of diverse needs and concerns of faculty members belonging to various disciplinary areas.

The course aims at preparing motivated and energized faculty which is capable of designing most appropriate pedagogical approaches to address diversity among students at higher education level. The rationale for the proposed faculty development programme has been derived from the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020 which has clearly focused upon the professional development of teachers engaged with higher education. This policy has taken into consideration the essentiality associated with enhancing the quality of learning experiences at higher education. The document underlines the long pending demand of enriching the pedagogical capacities of the teachers across all levels of education. A rigorous and engaging programme is required to address this emerging need to capacitate the faculty members across all discipline in a HEIs. The proposed course is conceptualized to facilitate the process of developing an in-depth understanding of multiple dimensions of pedagogical processes, thus contributing towards enhancing the quality of teaching-learning experiences at HE. This FDP will prepare the university teachers towards conceptualizing and designing the curricular and pedagogical approaches including selection of reading material and comprehensive assessment. The primary emphasis will be to capacitate them in creating effective learning environments addressing the diverse needs of the students.

- Attendance norms are strict. Participants are required to clear the assessment component for getting the certificates.

- **ELIGIBILITY:** The programme is **interdisciplinary** and is open to all interested participants. All faculty members **(Permanent/Temporary/Adhoc/Guest)** from any university/college are eligible to participate.

NOTE: The present round of this FDP is not for faculty members who are from the discipline of education and teacher education.
