CONCEPT NOTE

Therefore, it is important to understand the complex issues that require higher order thinking skills to analysis the research problems and provide solutions.

One of the most important attributes of a good scholar is the ability to explain the complexity into a organised way.

Academic writing refers to a style of expression that a scholar uses to define the intellectual boundaries of the discipline. Effective writing is a skill that is grounded in the cognitive domain. It involves learning, comprehension, application and synthesis of new knowledge. From a faculty member's perspective, writing well entails more than adhering to writing conventions. Writing also encompasses creative inspiration, problem-solving, reflection and revision that results in a completed manuscript. There is a significant need for students at all levels not only to be good written communicators, but also to understand the importance of good writing skills. In addition, an important facet of written communication is being able to critically assess the writing of others, particularly at the graduate level as well as in professional programs.
